Introduction to Speakers



Dr. Fanrong Liang is an academic leader of acupuncture and massage therapy nationwide and the director of the Key Laboratory of Meridian Acupoint Effects of the State Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine. He is also the vice chairman of the World Acupuncture Federation, the director of the Acupuncture-Moxibustion Acupuncture Committee of the Chinese Acupuncture Society, the executive director of the Chinese Association of Traditional Chinese Medicine, and president of

the Sichuan Acupuncture Association. He has practiced acupuncture in clinical settings for more than 40 years, and excels in using acupuncture to treat various types of pain syndromes, including cervical spondylosis, arthritis, sequelae of stroke, facial paralysis, bowel dysfunction, hypertension, and other diseases. He has published more than 450 academic papers, including more than 130 SCI-original papers—13 of which had an impact factor greater than five—and has obtained 32 national patents and 2 computer software copyrights.

梁繁荣,男,教授,博士生导师,国家重点学科针灸推拿学学科带头人,国家中医药管理局经穴效应重点研究室主任,享受政府特殊津贴专家,全国教学名师,全国优秀科技工作者,世界针灸联合会副主席,中国针灸学会循证针灸学专业委员会主任委员,中华中医药学会常务理事,四川省针灸学会会长,四川省十大名中医。从事针灸临床40多年,尤擅长运用针灸治疗各种痛证、颈椎病、关节炎、中风后遗症、面瘫、肠功能紊乱、高血压、冠心病、月经不调、更年期综合征、多囊卵巢综合征、慢性盆腔炎的研究,尤擅长针灸治疗神经系统、运动系统和妇科疾病。作为首席科学家两次主持国家重点基础研究(973)计划项目,主持中医药领域首个国家自然科学基金重大项目、国家自然基金重点项目、面上项目等课题59项,获国家科学技术进步二等奖1项、国家教学成果二等奖1项,部省级科技进步一等奖5项、二等奖4项、三等奖2项,部省级教学成果一等奖5项、二等奖2项,主编国家级规划教材8部、学术专著11部,发表学术论文450余篇,其中SCI源刊论文130余篇,影响因子大于5的论文13篇,获得国家授权专利32项、计算机软件著作权2项,培养了博硕士研究生150余人,其中1人获得全国百篇优秀博士论文奖、1人获得提全国百篇优秀博士论文名奖,被公认为国内外针灸研究领域的重要领军人物之一.



Xu Nenggui, M.D., is a professor of medicine, vice president of Guangzhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, member of the Science and Technology Committee of the Ministry of Education, and head of the National First Class Discipline in the National Key Discipline. He is a principal investigator of the Guangdong Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences and director of the South China Center for Acupuncture and Moxibustion, Guangzhou University of Chinese Medicine. He has been involved in acupuncture treatment of cerebrovascular diseases and has done considerable clinical research on the topic. He has published more than 100 academic papers in prestige journals. He has also written more than 10 books. He has won two first prizes for science and technology awards from

the Ministry of Education and a second prize for scientific and technological progress in Guangdong Province.

一直从事针灸治疗脑血管疾病的基础和临床研究工作。独立主持研究国家"973 计划"项目 1 项、国家自然科学基金课题 6 项、省部级课题 10 余项;在国内外公开发行的刊物上发表学术论文 100 余篇,编写学术专著 10 余部;主持研究的科研成果获国家教育部科学技术奖励一等奖 2 项、广东省科技进步二等奖 1 项;主持研究的教学成果获国家级教学成果二等奖 1 项、广东省教学成果一等奖 1 项。



Dr. Jianqiao Fang is currently the president of Zhejiang University of Chinese Medicine, deputy to the National People's Congress, vice president of the Chinese Acupuncture Association, president of the Zhejiang Academy of Acupuncture and Moxibustion, and vice chairman of Zhejiang Provincial Association of Science and Technology. He has long been engaged in the teaching, scientific research, and clinical work in Chinese acupuncture and moxibustion. He excels in using Traditional Chinese Medicine, acupuncture and moxibustion to treat rheumatism, insomnia, depression, sequelae of stroke, and various sub-health

condition. He is responsible for drafting medical treatment guidelines for shoulder periarthritis and trigeminal neuralgia. He has done extensive research on negative emotions and change induced by chronic pain. He has published more than 120 academic papers and was an editor-in-chief of eight books.

方剑乔,男,医学博士, 教授、主任中医师,现任浙江中医药大学校长,全国人大代表,中国针灸学会副会长、浙江省针灸学会会长、浙江省科协副主席; 为全国名老中医药专家工作室(方剑乔工作室)专家,全国名老中医学术思想指导老师,浙江省名中医; 全国优秀科技工作者、全国优秀医院院长、卫生部和浙江省有突出贡献的中青年专家、浙江省卫生领军人才、浙江省高校教学名师。长期从事中医针灸的教学、科研与临床工作,临床擅长运用中药、针灸治疗各类疼痛、风湿病、失眠、抑郁、中风后遗症和各种亚健康的调理; 主持肩周炎、三叉神经痛全国中医药诊疗指南的起草; 对慢性疼痛诱发负面情绪和痛认知的改变有较深的研究。先后主持国家级科研课题 7 项,获省部级科技成果一等奖 3 项,发表学术论文 120 余篇,其中 SCI 源刊论文 30 余篇。主编《刺法灸法学》国家规划教材、主编专著 8 部。



Dr. Qiang Wu is an executive board member of the Chinese
Acupuncture Society, the vice president of the Meridian Branch of the
Chinese Acupuncture Society, the vice president of the Clinical Branch
of the Chinese Acupuncture Society, a member of the editorial board of
the Chinese Journal of Acupuncture as well as of the Journal of
Acupuncture Research. He is also the president of the Fujian
Acupuncture Association. He was the leader of acupuncture and
moxibustion in the key disciplines of the State Administration of China
and the dean of the School of Acupuncture and Moxibustion at the
Fujian University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. He has been engaged

in acupuncture teaching, scientific research, and clinical work for more than 30 years. He mainly focuses on the research of the clinical and acupuncture treatment mechanism of pediatric encephalopathy.

吴强教授,医学博士,博导。现任中国针灸学会常务理事,中国针灸学会经络分会副会长,中国针灸学会临床分会副会长,《中国针灸》、《针刺研究》杂志编委,福建省针灸学会会长。曾任国家中管局重点学科针灸学学科带头人、福建省政协委员、福建中医药大学针灸学院院长、香港大学继续教育学院校外考试主任、台湾长庚大学客座教授、澳大利亚澳华中医针灸学会顾问。从事针灸教学、科研、临床工作30余年,主要从事小儿脑病的临床及针灸治疗机理研究。近年来带领多位博士、硕士研究生从事具有福建特色的"经络刮疗"的临床与机理研究取得了一定进展。参与"973"项目研究3项,主持国家自然基金2项、省部级项目8项。获省部级科技进步奖3项。



Dr. Sanhua Leng graduated from Hubei University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Tongji Medical College of Huazhong University of Science & Technology, and Dominican College, where he obtained his BA in Chinese Medicine, MA in Integrated Chinese & Western Medicine, and doctorate in physical therapy, respectively. He is a licensed physical therapist and acupuncturist, certified Mulligan Practitioner. He has been doing clinical and research work in Integrated Chinese and Western Medicine for over 20 years. He has published four articles in SCI accepted journals; one article received an Excellent Paper Honor from the China Association for Science and Technology. One of the projects he participated in got a

Science and Technology Progress Award from the Wuhan Government. In recent years, he has explained the functional phenomena of meridian in the view of C nerve network, and how to select and pair acupoints in tissues that distributed with sensitized C nerve. He has explained the body position in acupoints determination with pain gate theory, set up differentiation palpation techniques for five different tissues, and integrated them into Counter Stimulation Therapy for manual and acupuncture therapy. The value of Counter Stimulation Therapy is recognized.

冷三华先后在湖北中医药大学获得中医学士、华中科技大学同济医学院获得中西医结合硕士和美国 Dominican College 获得物理治疗博士。现为理疗师、针灸师、认证穆里根治疗师。他从事中西医结合临床、科研二十多年,承担国家自然科学基金项目,发表 SCI 收录杂志论文四篇,获得第五届中国科协优秀论文奖,湖北省科技进步三等奖。近年来提出用 C 神经网络系统解释针灸经络功能现象,用敏化 C 神经分布的组织指导针灸取穴、配穴,用疼痛的阀门机制解释《黄帝内经》取穴的体位要求,采用五体鉴别触诊方法,整合成逆向刺激疗法,用于痛症、非痛症的针灸、手法治疗,取得了很好的临床疗效,临床实践得到了认可。



Dr. Mark W. Green is Director of the Center for Headache and Pain Medicine and Professor of Neurology and Anesthesiology at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine. He recently came to Mount Sinai from Columbia University, where he was Director of Headache Medicine and Clinical Professor of Neurology (in Neurology, Anesthesiology and Dentistry) at the College of Physicians and Surgeons and the College of Dental Medicine. He is certified in Neurology by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology and in Headache Medicine through the United Council for Neurologic Subspecialties.

Dr. Green graduated from Case Western Reserve University, and received his medical degree from the Albert Einstein College of Medicine. He received his neurology training at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and during that period worked in the Montefiore Headache Unit of Albert Einstein. He was later appointed director of that unit. He came to Columbia University in 1981, and then New York Medical College. He returned to Columbia University ten years ago to organize a section on headache and facial pain in the department of neurology.

Dr. Green was elected to the Board of Directors of the National Headache Foundation in spring 2010. He was one of the founding editors of *Cephalagia*, the international headache journal. He also served as the associate editor of *Headache*, the journal of the American Headache Society and is currently the abstract editor of that journal. He has a long-standing interest in neuropharmacology and is a panel member of the Advisory Board of the Food and Drug Administration's Section on Peripheral and Central Neurological Drugs.

Dr. Green has been active in the practice of headache and facial pain since 1978. He has lectured throughout the world on this subject and has written numerous articles on various subjects concerning headache and facial pain.

Dr. Jiabei Wang is a professor at University of Maryland School of Pharmacy, Baltimore, a faculty position she has held since 1995.

A 1982 medical graduate of Tongji Medical University in China, she moved to the United States to pursue her research career in 1987. She received a Ph.D. in pharmacology from the University of Maryland School of Medicine in 1991. After postdoctoral training at Johns Hopkins University and NIDA/NIH, she joined the faculty of the School of Pharmacy as a tenure-track assistant professor in 1995, was promoted to associate professor with tenure in 2000, and full professor in

2006.

As a principal investigator with an established research program and national reputation in opioid receptor research, her primary research is on drug addiction and mental illnesses, which has been continuously supported by NIDA/NIH for the last 20 years. She has published more than 80 scientific articles and reviews, and has been awarded two patents for the discovery of human mu opioid receptor gene as well as for a novel pharmacotherapy for cocaine addiction. She has trained many graduate students and postdoctoral fellows in her laboratory. In addition to all her research endeavors, Dr. Wang is an enthusiastic teacher for the Pharm.D. students and contributes greatly to the University and scientific community. She has served as a regular member for NIH study sections for many years. She has also been the principal of the local Chinese school since 1998.



Dr. Steven P. Cohen obtained his medical degree at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine, completed an anesthesiology residency at Columbia University, and a pain management fellowship at Massachusetts General Hospital. Currently, he is Professor of Anesthesiology & Critical Care Medicine, as well as Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, at the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine and Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. He is also Director of the Blaustein Pain Treatment Center, Medical Education and Quality Assurance for the Pain Management Division

at Johns Hopkins, and Director of Pain Research at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center.

Dr. Cohen has been very active in teaching and pain research in recent years, having published over 250 peer-reviewed articles, reviews and book chapters in the past 15 years. Among his major contributions are the development of an FDA-approved technique for treating sacroiliac joint pain (lateral branch radiofrequency denervation), for the invention of the intravenous ketamine test to help guide treatment in patients with chronic pain, and performing the first studies evaluating the epidural administration of biological agents for pain. These articles have been featured in some of the top general medical journals including *Lancet*, *CMAJ*, *BMJ*, *Annals of Internal Medicine* and *JAMA-Internal Medicine*. His research has been the subject of articles in the Science Section of the New York *Times* on four separate occasions. He has been the first author of the chapter on *Pain* in the last two editions of *Cecil Textbook of Medicine*,

and was listed in 2014 as one of the top 10 experts in the world for back pain based on quantitative analysis of publications.

In addition to his academic work, Dr. Cohen is a retired colonel in the U.S. Army, and was deployed four times in support of operations in Bosnia, Iraq and Afghanistan. He also serves as the Reserve Liaison to the Pain Management Consultants to the U.S. Army and Navy Surgeons General. Dr. Cohen has previously presented data on pain management in service members to the U.S. Congress, FDA and General Officers. His research was instrumental in the passage of the 2008 Military Pain Care Act, and he served as an inaugural member of the U.S. Army Medical Advisory Board. His previous awards include the American Society of Regional Anesthesia & Pain Medicine John J. Bonica Award, ASIPP Public Service Award, Donlin M. Long Pain Award, Michael J. Cousins Award Lecture, American Academy of Pain Medicine Founder's Award, the Order of Military Medical Merit, and the Legion of Merit.

Bing Zhu obained his Ph.D. in Life Science, from Université Paris VI, and he is the chief scientist of the China Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences (CACMS). He was a postdoctoral fellow of the National Institute of Health and Medicine, France, and the former director of the Institute of Acupuncture, CACMS. He is the academic leader of Acupuncture in State Administration of TCM, the director of Key Laboratory of Meridian Research, and the chief scientist of the National Basic Research Program of China. He is the vice president of China Association Acupuncture-Moxibustion, and the Chairman of the Acupuncture Subjects and

Academic Committee of China Association Acupuncture-Moxibustion. He is the Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Acupuncture Research*. Professor Zhu has been working on acupuncture research for decades; he has published more than 200 scientific articles and two books, *Systems Acu-medicine* and *Scientific Basis of Acupuncture*.

朱兵,巴黎第6大学生命科学博士,中国中医科学院首席研究员,针灸研究所前所长;国家973项目首席科学家。原创性提出针灸等体表刺激疗法与生物进化相关,提出了穴位效应规律分类的"单元"和"集元"假说。率先倡导了特异性效应标志的穴位敏化理论和"穴位敏化池"的微理化环境概念,提出穴位就是能与相应靶器官发生 cross-talk 的体表位域。创立了"皮-脑轴与针灸广谱效应"的观点,穴位刺激触发的皮肤细胞分泌糖皮质激素与免疫调节是针灸发挥非特异调节的关键因素。首次证实耳迷走神经部分传入与孤束核的联系,提出耳-迷走神经是耳针发挥特异效应机制的论点;并采用自主研发的经皮耳迷走神经刺激仪治疗癫痫和抑郁症等取得良好的临床疗效。



Emily Vertosick is a master biostatistician at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York. For the past five years, she has served as the statistician for the Acupuncture Trialists' Collaboration, a large individual patient data meta-analysis on the use of acupuncture for chronic pain. She has also contributed to Cochrane reviews of acupuncture for chronic pain, as well as working on studies of acupuncture in cancer patients. Her other research focuses on urologic cancers, including prostate cancer screening and detection.



Dr. Neel Mehta is both board-certified in Anesthesia, and fellowship trained, board-certified in Interventional Pain Medicine.

He holds several positions including:

- Medical Director of Pain Medicine at the Weill-Cornell Pain Medicine Center, and New York Presbyterian Hospital, overseeing outpatient and inpatient services together with a large team of dedicated Pain and Regional Anesthesia Physicians.

- Dean's Healthcare Leadership Fellow

- Weill Cornell Medical School, Course Director in Pain Medicine

Dr. Mehta was recently selected by his peers as one of Super Doctors New York 'Rising Stars'-- an honor roll of the top New York doctors in more than 30 specialties who have been fully licensed for 10 years or less.

Pain is one of the most common reasons people consult a physician, yet it is often inadequately treated. Dr. Mehta's goals are to optimize pain control, enhance functional ability as well as physical and psychological well-being, and quality of life. He focuses on, but is not limited to, musculoskeletal pain of the back, neck, and joints, neuropathic disorders, and cancer pain. His clinical interests lie in the minimally invasive procedures to treat musculoskeletal pain, including various types of injections, intrathecal pump therapy, Spinal Cord Stimulation, and the MILD© Procedure (Minimally Invasive Lumbar Decompression) for Spinal Stenosis. He is an active participant in research regarding Spinal Cord Stimulation, and has published numerous textbook chapters on Cancer Pain, Back Pain, and Spinal Cord Stimulation.

Dr. Yanmei Li is a professor, chief physician, and mentor of graduate students at Henan University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. She is director emeritus of the Brain Disease Division of the First Hospital affiliated with Henan University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. She is also the director of the Headache Research Institute of Henan University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Chairman of Headache Branch of Henan Association of Chinese and Western Medicine, Deputy Chairman of Henan Association of Rehabilitation Education. She is a standing member of the Committee on Neurodegenerative Diseases of the China

Microcirculation Society and an executive director of the Brain Disease Branch of the Chinese National Medical Association.
